



## **Class of 2012 Graduation Night Party**

### **When & how:**

- Tuesday, June 12, after graduation: Students board charter buses at Meany Hall immediately following graduation.
- Wednesday, June 13, at 5:45 AM: Parents pick up students at the Temple parking lot. It is important for parents to pick up the kids, because they will be exhausted, overwhelmed, and should not drive themselves.
