

Senior Yukon/Alaska Trip 2012

March 22 – April 1

Dates: Thursday, March 22: Leaving from school in the morning, the group will be bussed to Vancouver. Fly from Vancouver to Whitehorse, Canada and then bus to Lake LeBarge.
Thursday, March 22 – Sunday, March 25: At Lake LeBarge.
Monday, March 26: Group is bussed to Skagway and catches a ferry to Ketchikan.
Wednesday, March 28: Ferry arrives in Ketchikan, group heads out to the homestead.
Wednesday, March 28 – Saturday, March 31: Group out at the homestead.
Sunday, April 1: Picked up by Allen Marine, tour Misty Fjords, fly home that evening.*

*The group will return to Sea-Tac in the PM on Sunday, April 1. Due to the size of the group, the return flights will be staggered throughout the day on April 1 but assume an evening return.

Group Size: We'll take as many seniors as want to come!

Cost: \$1500 – Cost includes airfare, ferry, food, boat costs, transportation costs in town, etc. Students only need spending money for personal items. Participants will also need to procure appropriate clothing.

Signup/ Payment: Deposits should be sent to Gayle Pearl and are due by November 29. They are non-refundable. The \$1500 should be paid in full by March 1. Follow-up \$500 payments are due February 1 and March 1.

Necessary Forms: We will be putting together multiple copies of the trip form notebooks, as required for the Alaska Marine Highway and multiple Canada/ US border crossings. We need to make multiple **photocopies** of the following forms, and we need your help ASAP in accumulating all of the necessary paperwork:

- **Passport**
- Drivers License/ State ID card
- Signed Trip permission slip
- Current address, emergency contact #'s

Students will be required to bring their passport and drivers license with them; government issued photo ID is required for the ferry and plane, and the passport is required for the Canadian border crossings.
